Antonyms: Straight



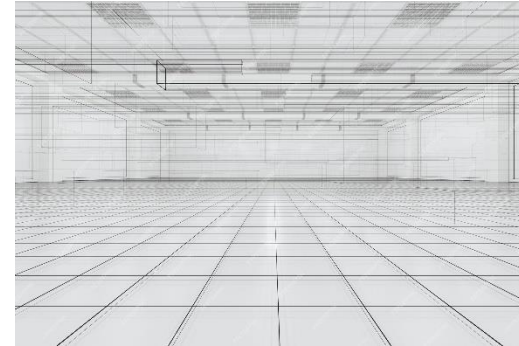

Antonyms: Irreligious, unimportant

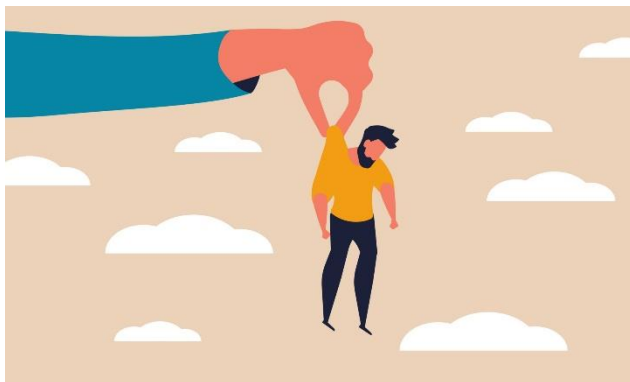


Dismiss

Synonyms: Altar, temple

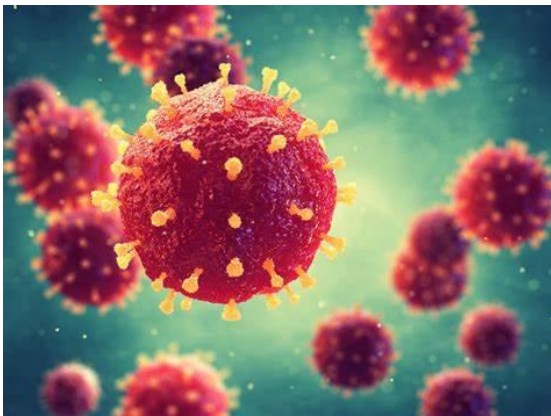


Malady
