Meaning: Intending to harm

Synonyms: Malevolent, malignant, wicked

Transparent

Meaning: See-through or open, honest, and easy to understand

Synonyms: Candid, easy, clear

Antonyms: Opaque, difficult, convoluted

Antonyms: Meagre, lacking, inadequate



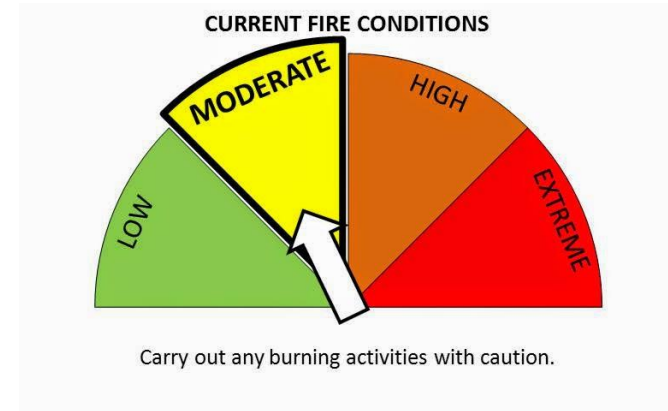
